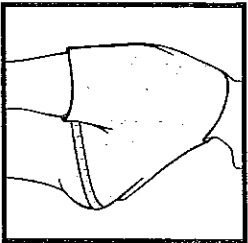


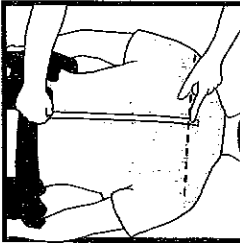
1. Female ABA Steps For Tape Measuring



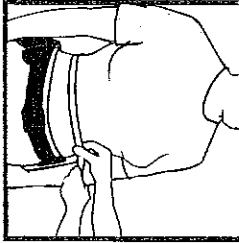
1. Take a front standing chest measurement. With officer facing away from you, have her put the tape measure across the nipple line with her arms relaxed at her sides. This measurement, along with her cup size, determines the front and back panel size. On the reverse side of this form, place the chest size in the **Front and Back Sample Size** boxes and the officer's cup size in the **Cup Size** box. (Ex: 38 C)



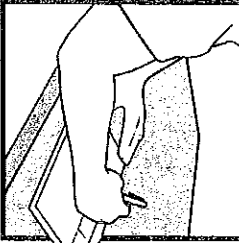
2. Take a front-seated measurement. Making sure that the officer is in a relaxed seated position, measure from the clavicle notch to a point above the duty belt. Ensure that the front panel's edge WILL NOT touch the duty belt or its accessories while seated. Using the chart, determine the front-seated panel length needed and place that size on the reverse side in the **Front Seated Measurement** box. (Ex: R or L or X-1)



3. Take a back-standing measurement. Using the natural shoulder line, select a point at the middle of the back. Measure from that location to a point above the duty belt. Ensure that the back panels edge WILL NOT touch the duty belt or its accessories while standing. Using the chart, determine the back standing panel length needed and place that size on the reverse side in the **Back Standing Measurement** box. (Ex: R or L or X-1)



4. Take a standing girth measurement. Measure around the officer's girth or waist at its widest point. Generally, this will be either approximately two inches above the duty belt or along the belly-button line. Ensure that the soft tape measure is not hindered by the officer's equipment. Using the chart, determine the girth panel size needed and place that size on the reverse side in the **Side Standing Measurement** box. (Ex: R or L or X) (If the girth tape measurement falls in between two sizes, we recommend you select the larger size to ensure the panel's edges touch or overlap.)



5. Place the **Front Sample Size, Cup Size, Front-Seated Measurement, Back Sample Size, Back Standing, and Side Standing** measurements that you recorded on the reverse side into the **Actual Size** box. (Ex: 38CF / 38 RR)

Individuals whose size exceeds the "X" designation can be properly sized by adding needed one-inch increments (X+1, X+2, etc.)
Individuals whose size falls below the "S" designation can be properly sized by **subtracting a one-inch increment only (S-1)**
