**Ballistic Shield/Breaching Instructor Course  
March 28-31, 2011 \$599**

Four day train-the trainer level course for SWAT/SRT/Firearms instructors on practical use of the ballistic shield in SWAT and active shooter scenarios. Instructor level course for tactical breaching, including, manual, shotgun, combination, power assisted, and vehicle assisted breaching. Explosive breaching will be discussed.

June 6-10, 2011 \$599**

5 Day, 50 hour TLCEOSE firearms instructor course, with integrated topics of shooting while moving, tactical and patrol oriented drill development, drills for vicious animals, night fire, concealed/backup, and integrated shotgun.

Prior to his career at DEA, he was a officer for the DC Metropolitan PD. After leaving SigArms, he was recruited to develop the Action Target Academy, where he is still active as an adjunct instructor.
